

Enemy Swim Sanitation District Meeting August 29, 2025

Trustees set meeting dates for 2026

Call to Order: By: Paul Moxness **Time:** 4:05 PM

Present: Verlin Hoffer, Paul Moxness, Carole Thomas and Kim Heimerl.

Guests: Bill Coester.

Approval of July 2025 Minutes: Minutes were made available for review together with the approved 2026 budget. Kim Heimerl made a motion to approve the minutes pending revisions to the financial report. Verlin Hoffer seconded that motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Kim Heimerl gave the treasurers report and explained which checks need to be written. A bill from Kevin Gaikowski will be coming at the end of summer. Luke Keller will also be sending a bill the end of the summer. Carole Thomas made a motion to approve payment for the outstanding debts. Verlin Hoffer seconded that motion. The motion passed unanimously. A financial report of expenses/income will be included in the September minutes.

Old Business: Election of trustees .was discussed. The only nomination was from Paul Moxness. As there are no other nominations, the election will be cancelled.

New Business: There was one request for a septic permit. All requirements for approval were met and has been checked by Kevin Gaikowski, a certified installer. Carole Thomas made a motion to approve that permit, and Kim Hoffer seconded that motion. The motion was passed.

It was noted that Dennis Skadson was honored by the Day County Conservation Commission for his 30 plus years of service in collecting water quality data of area lakes. We congratulate Dennis on his years of service. Tom Grady sends out a report from the Enemy Swim Preservation Association (ESPA). In his report, Tom Grady stated that there have not been any invasive weeds found in Enemy Swim Lake. Our thanks to the ESPA for their continued work to keep and improve the lake quality on Enemy Swim Lake.

Kim Heimerl noted that letters have gone out from Day County to the residents regarding permits for any lakefront renovations.

The 2026 meeting dates were scheduled as 5/29, 6/26, 7/31, 8/28, and 9/11. The election will be held on 9/8.

Bill Coester administered the oath of office to Paul Moxness who will serve as a trustee for a 3 year term.

Adjournment: Carole Thomas made a motion to adjourn, and Verlin Hoffer seconded that motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 4:38 PM.
